About a week ago, the Adolph Coors Foundation took possession of its new offices in Cherry Creek North. This culminated a two-year process of conceptual planning, interviewing and selecting architects and contractors, negotiating with the City, managing an incredibly aggressive construction schedule and, finally, commissioning the building.

Much to the delight of the Coors family, this massive undertaking was <u>completed on-time and on-budget</u> and with less than a half-dozen change orders. And, for that, we thank David Wells.

David ably represented the family's interest in this project from start to finish. He embraced the family's vision for the building and used his extensive construction experience to help the Foundation navigate the inevitable, and often costly, pitfalls associated with a project of this size.
